Bilal ibn Rabah

4(Every one of us has 4 angels assigned to us! 2 that protect us (1 in front and 1 behind), and 2 that record us (1 on each side of us))

**11 What is the name of the angel that will blow the trumpet to signal the coming of the Day of Judgement?**

Israfil (AS)

**12 Do angels have wings?**

Yes

**13 What were Jibreel (AS)'s first instructions to the Prophet (S)?**

Read!

**14 Can angels take on a human-like form?**

Yes

**15 Umar ibn al-Khattab (RA) reported:**

**“We were sitting with the Messenger of Allah (S), peace and blessings be upon him, one day when a man appeared with very white clothes and very black hair. There were no signs of travel on him and we did not recognise him. He sat down in front of the Prophet (S) and rested his knees by his knees and placed his hands on his thighs...”**

Jibreel (AS)

**16 Are angels capable of disobeying Allah?**

No (“Believers, guard yourselves and your families against a Fire fuelled by people and stones, over which stand angels, stern and strong; angels who never disobey God’s commands to them, but do as they are ordered:”)

**17 What are angels made from?**

Light

**18 What are the names of the angels that watch over heaven and hell? (respectively)**

Ridwan (Heaven) and Malik (Hell)

**19 In what Battle were thousands of angels sent down to help the Muslim army win?**

Battle of Badr

**20 How many angels will question us in our graves?**

2 (Munkar and Nakir are the angels assigned to question people in their graves about their faith.)

**21 Does the angel recording our bad deeds to the left of us write them down into our Record immediately?**

No, there is a delay where the angel waits before writing  
(It is reported that the Prophet (S) said:

“Truly the Angel on the left [of a person] withholds from recording the sinful deed committed by the Muslim servant who sinned for a period six ‘hours’. If the servant regrets committing the sin and asks Allah for forgiveness, the Angel does not write down his sin. Otherwise, the angel records it as one bad deed.”) [at-Tabarani, al-Mu`jam al-Kabir]

**22 Do angels eat and drink?**

No

(When the angels were sent to Ibrahim (AS) to deliver glad tidings of a son, in Surah adh-Dharyat, Allah says:

“He [Ibrahim (AS)] turned quickly to his household, brought out a fat calf, and placed it before them. ‘Will you not eat?’ he said, beginning to be afraid of them, but they said, ‘Do not be afraid.’ They gave him good news of a son who would be gifted with knowledge.”)

[51:26-28]

**23 What did the Angels say to Allah when they found out man was to be sent to Earth? They were hesitant and asked God why, when they worship Him perfectly**

“[Prophet], when your Lord told the angels, ‘I am putting a successor on earth,’ they said, ‘How can You put someone there who will cause damage and bloodshed, when we celebrate Your praise and proclaim Your holiness?’ but He said, ‘I know things you do not.’”
